Do you or others have trouble understanding your child? Does your child mix up sounds or leave out syllables? (ex. says “phant” instead of “elephant” or “led” for “red”) Is your toddler using two word sentences? (ex.: “Me down” instead of “I want to get down.”). Small delays in speech and language abilities are easier to address at a young age.

If you have such concerns about your child aged five and under, the Wellness Centre offers families with English-speaking children the opportunity to meet with a speech-language pathologist for a free screening session. It will take place in the Partners’ meeting room on the 2nd floor in the Jeffery Hale Pavilion, 1270 chemin Sainte-Foy, Quebec, G1S 2M4. Free parking!
