CLSC-type services in English to promote the well being of English-speaking people in the *Capitale-Nationale* region. They also work with clinics, hospitals and others to meet your health and social services needs. **Services include:**

- Baby & Toddler Vaccination Clinic: Help protect your child from some serious diseases by having them vaccinated.
- Letters to Daddy: A series of letters about growing up written from a baby's point of view.
- OLo: Eggs, milk, frozen vegetables and vitamins for pregnant women with low income, and the support of a nurse, nutritionist or social worker.
- Online prenatal classes: Topics include lifestyle during pregnancy, becoming parents, labour and delivery, and feeding and caring for a newborn.
- Prenatal clinic: Come talk with a nurse about pregnancy, delivery, bringing baby home after birth & breastfeeding. Blood tests by prescription. Referrals to birthing centres & other resources.
- Postnatal visits: A nurse will meet with you after the birth of your baby.
- Postpartum Depression Screening: This very short quiz helps ensure that all is going well for new mothers.
- SIPPE: supports women with low income who have not finished high school or are isolated, during pregnancy until your child starts school.
