CATEGORY 3 BURSARY

The Category 3 Bursary provides financial support to students pursuing full-time studies in health and social service programs in a government-recognized vocational training centre located within their region.

The Category 3 Bursary amounts are fixed based on the student's level of study for full-time studies in the 2018-2019 Academic Year:

- \$2000 per student registered for full-time studies in the 2018-2019 academic year
