CATEGORY 1 BURSARY

The Category 1 Bursary provides financial support to students pursuing full-time studies in the area of health and social services outside their region. The Category 1 Bursary amounts are fixed and based on the student's level of study in the 2021-2022 academic year.

- University: \$10,000 per student registered for full-time studies
- Cégep / college: \$5,000 per student registered for full-time studies

Students wishing to apply for the Category 1 Bursary Program must submit their application forms to efleming@jhpartners.net before 5:00 p.m. on May 7, 2021.

CATEGORY 2 BURSARY

The Category 2 Bursary provides financial support to students pursuing full-time studies in the area of health and social services within their region. The Category 2 Bursary amounts are fixed and based on the student's level of study in the 2021-2022 academic year.

- University: \$5,000 per student registered for full-time studies
- Cégep / college: \$2,500 per student registered for full-time studies
- *Vocational training: \$2,000 per students registered for full-time studies

Students wishing to apply for the Category 2 Bursary Program must submit their application forms to efleming@jhpartners.net before 5:00 p.m. on May 7, 2021.

*For students in a vocational training program, the bursary application is an open call and can be submitted at any point during the 2021-2022 academic year
