ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Accompany and assist participants during recreational activities;
- Animation and realization of the activities planned in the calendar;
- Participate in the organization of special events with themes in collaboration with the Special Needs Coordinator;
- Set up and clean up before and after activities;
- Provide support and supervision to clients in order to help maintain and develop their autonomy;
- Together with the participants and their families, participate in the development and evaluation of their individualized intervention plan;
- Participate in the evaluation of the clientele and collaborate with various stakeholders from the community and the public system;
- Ensure the statistical documentation of participation in activities;
- -Handle personal information regarding participants, their families, volunteers and staff in a confidential manner and respond with sensitivity;
- Use intervention techniques that can promote a return to calm and order;
- Perform any other related duties.

REQUIREMENTS

Academic training

- Technical diploma (DEC or higher) in special education or a related field;
- A minimum of 2 years' experience in a related position.

Specific requirements

- Because the tasks will be performed with a vulnerable clientele that is not functional in the French language, proficiency in both official languages, both oral and written is required;
- Knowledge of the English-speaking community of Quebec City and its organizations would be an asset;
- Valid driver's license (the use of a personal vehicle may be required) would be an asset.
- Good understanding and comfort in working with people with an Autism Spectrum Disorder Diagnosis.

Professional and personal skills

- Capacity to adapt, team player, collaborative;
- Sense of responsibility and good judgment;
- Respect for the cultural, linguistic and economic diversity of our clientele;
- Comfortable interacting with the public of all ages and capacities (children, seniors, special needs, etc.);
- Highly organized, ability to manage a variety of tasks;
- Good knowledge of technology, along with an ability and willingness to learn other tools as required.
- Sense of observation and vigilance at all times to ensure the safety of participants;
- Good physical stamina, including the ability to push a wheelchair.

WORKING CONDITIONS

Contract, 28 to 35 hours/week, from August 2024 to mid July 2025 (possibility of renewal). You will be required to work evenings and weekends: Every other Friday evening from October to June, between 25-30 weekends (either Saturday or Sunday, schedule to be discussed with candidate).

Should the employment be extended after the six-month contract period, the person will have access to a range of benefits, including group insurance and a pension fund.

The hourly rate varies between \$24.80 and \$35.67 per hour, according to experience.
